Appointed by Mayor Karen Bass and unanimously confirmed by City Council, he serves as a Commissioner on the Los Angeles City Planning Commission, shaping zoning, housing, and land use policy. He is also Vice President of the Wilbur May Foundation, directing over \$3 million annually to LA youth, family, and LGBTQ+ programs, and led the family's \$6.5M lead gift for the Anita May Rosenstein Campus at the Los Angeles LGBT Center.

Brian Rosenstein is a Los Angeles City Planning Commissioner appointed by Mayor Karen Bass and unanimously confirmed by City Council, and the Chairman & CEO of Brookhill Corp., a privately held real estate investment firm he has led since 2018. Founded in 1977 by his grandfather David May II, Brookhill owns and manages a diversified national portfolio of multifamily, industrial, retail, and storage assets — over \$500 million across 15 states. A fourth-generation Angeleno and member of the May family, Brian serves as Vice President of the Wilbur May Foundation, which distributes more than \$3 million in annual charitable giving, and led the family's \$6.5M lead gift for the Anita May Rosenstein Campus at the Los Angeles LGBT Center. He also serves and has served as a political advisor across federal, state, and local races — including Congressman Mark Takano (D-Riverside, CA-39), Will Rollins for Congress (Democrat, CA-41, 2022), Campaign Chair for Julian Gold's successful Beverly Hills City Council race, Finance Chair for Jake Manaster's Beverly Hills School Board victory, campaign advisor to Noah Margo and Howard Goldstein for their successful Beverly Hills School Board bids, and volunteer for Willie Brien's successful Beverly Hills City Council race. He is available as a policy, real estate, and political commentator.
